The National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) mandates the use of a uniform private placement number (PPN) by insurers to identify investments in annual statements filed with State Regulatory Authorities.

CUSIP Global Services (CGS) was selected by NAIC to create, assign, and administer the PPN system (a CUSIP-like numbering system).
