The CUSIP Entity Identifier (CEI) is a 10-character code designed to uniquely identify legal entities in the loan market. CGS developed it in collaboration with the Loan Syndications & Trading Association (LSTA) and emerging syndicated loan solution providers focused on modernizing the syndicated loan market.

Features

- 10-character identifier with built-in intelligence to allow relationships to be easily identified and linked
- · A front-end UI with download capabilities
- Free to all market participants with no restrictions on distribution
- · Cross referenced to other entity identifiers, including LEI
- Loan-party entity records reviewed annually for accuracy

Benefits

- Provides complete transparency into the entities participating in the syndicated loan market, including critical fund manager relationships for multi-managed funds
- Gives market participants full visibility into the underlying legal entities related to each syndicated loan
- Open The CEI data will be accessible in the marketplace and has the capability to freely cross reference to other entity identifiers, e.g., the LEI
- Connectivity Deal and Facility CUSIPs will now have a CGS Entity ID
- Interoperable CGS connects with Banks, Asset Managers, Information Service Providers, Exchanges, Depositories, Broker Dealers globally
- Experienced successful track record of working with the LSTA and loan market participants in creating and widely adopting CUSIPs for syndicated loans


