The CUSIP Pulse file is CUSIP Global Services' fastest data feed offering designed to bring CUSIP security assignments and activity to Users in a frequency that meets their near real-time needs. CUSIP Pulse is a fifteen minute delta file that contains all change activity that takes place throughout the business day alongside newly assigned CGS identifiers and reference data. The service provides CUSIP numbers, standardized descriptions and up to 60 additional data attributes for corporate, municipal, U.S. government and sovereign securities whose issuers are domiciled in the US and Canada or whose issues will settle in the U.S. and Canada. The initial database master file contains over ten million issues from over 350,000 issuers.

- More timely master file maintenance, income processing and validation of new purchases
- Faster automation of front- and back-office operations
