Processes: Assigning CUSIP (US and Canada)

Equity

- Public (unrestricted) equity offering by U.S. or Canadian issuer
- Private (restricted) equity offering in U.S. by any issuer
 - Rule 144A, Regulation D
- American/Global Depositary Receipts (ADR/GDR)

Debt

- Public or private debt offering in U.S. by any issuer
 - SEC-registered, Rule 144A, Regulation D



Processes: Assigning CINS (International)

Equity

- Equity offered solely outside U.S. and Canada
 - ➤ U.S. company Regulation S stock offering on U.K. AIM exchange or in Germany
- Public offerings in U.S. by non-U.S./Canadian issuer (except GDR/ADR)
 - Cayman Islands, Bermuda and other non-U.S./Canadian issuers

Debt

- Debt offered solely outside U.S. and Canada
 - Regulation S (any issuer)
 - > Eurobonds




Processes: Sample CUSIP

Structure of a CUSIP

CGS provides a 9-character standard CUSIP identifier for issuers and their financial instruments offered in the U.S. and Canada

Example: Amazon.com Inc – Common Stock






Processes: Sample CINS

Structure of a CINS

CGS provides a 9-character standard CINS identifier for non-U.S./Canadian financial instruments

Example: Abingdon Capital PLC – Shares

Processes: General Procedures

Securities Offerings

- New Public or Private Offering (prospectus, offering document)
- Corporate Action
 - Name change
 - Company merger, acquisition or reorganization
 - Chapter 11 bankruptcy reorganization
 - > Reverse stock split
- CUSIP assigned pre-sale/pre-trade
 - Preliminary information
 - Data Quality Group focused on final validation of descriptive data and customer support/queries
- Internet Requests at <u>www.cusip.com</u>
 - CUSIPRequest
- Express assignments within one hour



Processes: General Procedures

- CUSIP identifiers are not reused except for discount commercial paper, government agency discount notes and TBA mortgage pools
- A security is assigned a CUSIP <u>or</u> CINS; <u>and</u> one ISIN
- Fungibility:
 - One CUSIP and one ISIN if shares trade on multiple stock exchanges or denominated in different currencies
 - Separate CUSIPs and ISINs if debt issued in different tranches or classes by currency, for example U.S. dollar tranche and Euro tranche
 - Separate CUSIPs and ISINs for each transfer/ownership type: SEC-registered (unrestricted), Rule 144A, Accredited Investors and Regulation S
